



# Textured Flower Applique

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Janome Maker

# Supplies

- 5" x 5" hoop (Janome SQ 14)
- 10" x 10" square of Pellon Fabric Magic
- 10" x 10" square of fabric for textured flower
- Base fabric (hand towel, t-shirt, etc)
- Embroidery thread
- Applique scissors, or sharp, curved embroidery scissors (the embroidery scissors supplied with your Janome are perfect)
- Stabilizer (dependent upon your base fabric. Follow manufacturer's instructions. I used a medium weight tear-away for my hand towel)
- Texture for applique .jef file
- Textured flower applique .jef file



# Step 1:

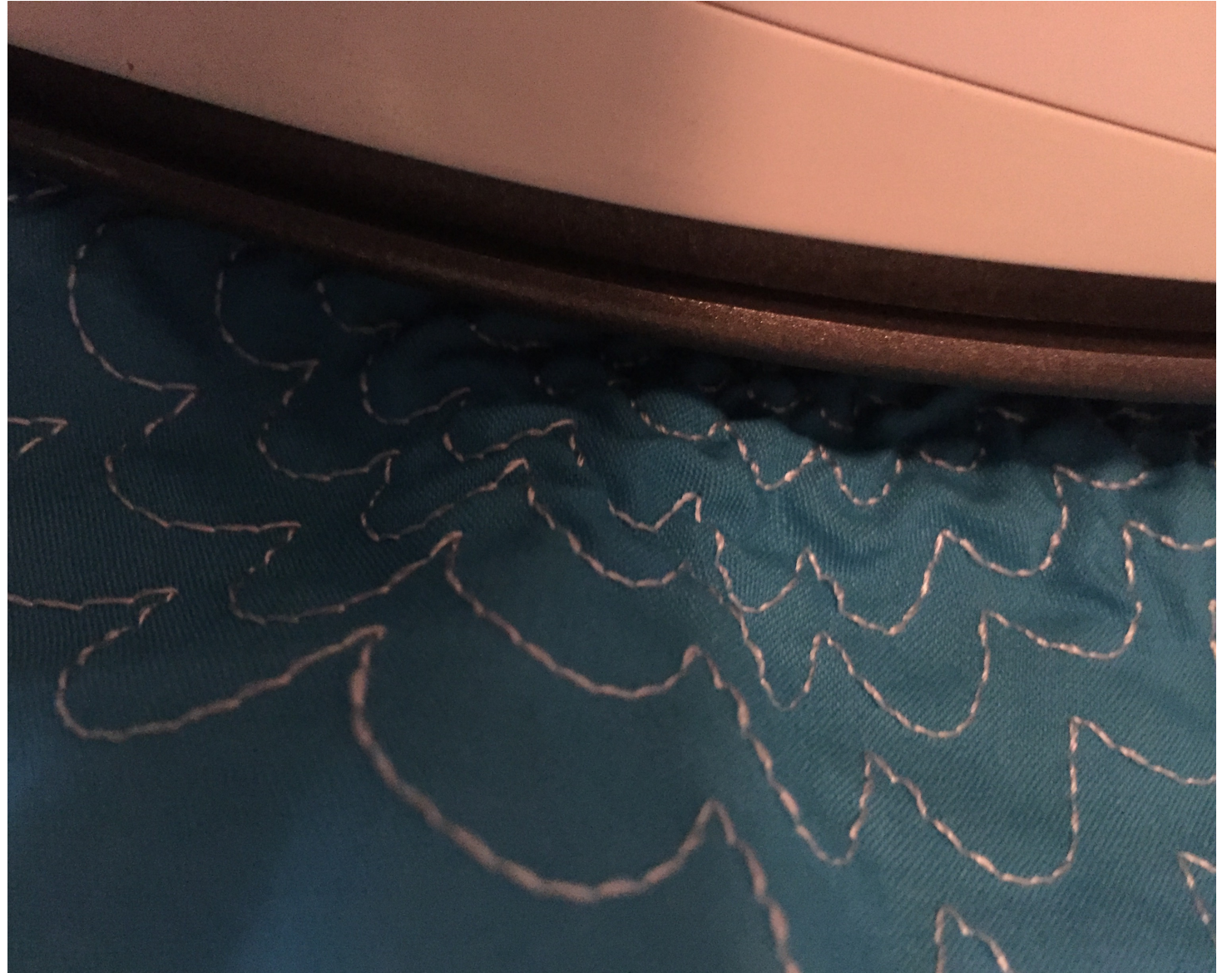
- Hoop Fabric Magic beneath fabric for textured flower
- Load hoop in machine
- Load Texture for Applique file
- Press start
- This will embroider a filet pattern



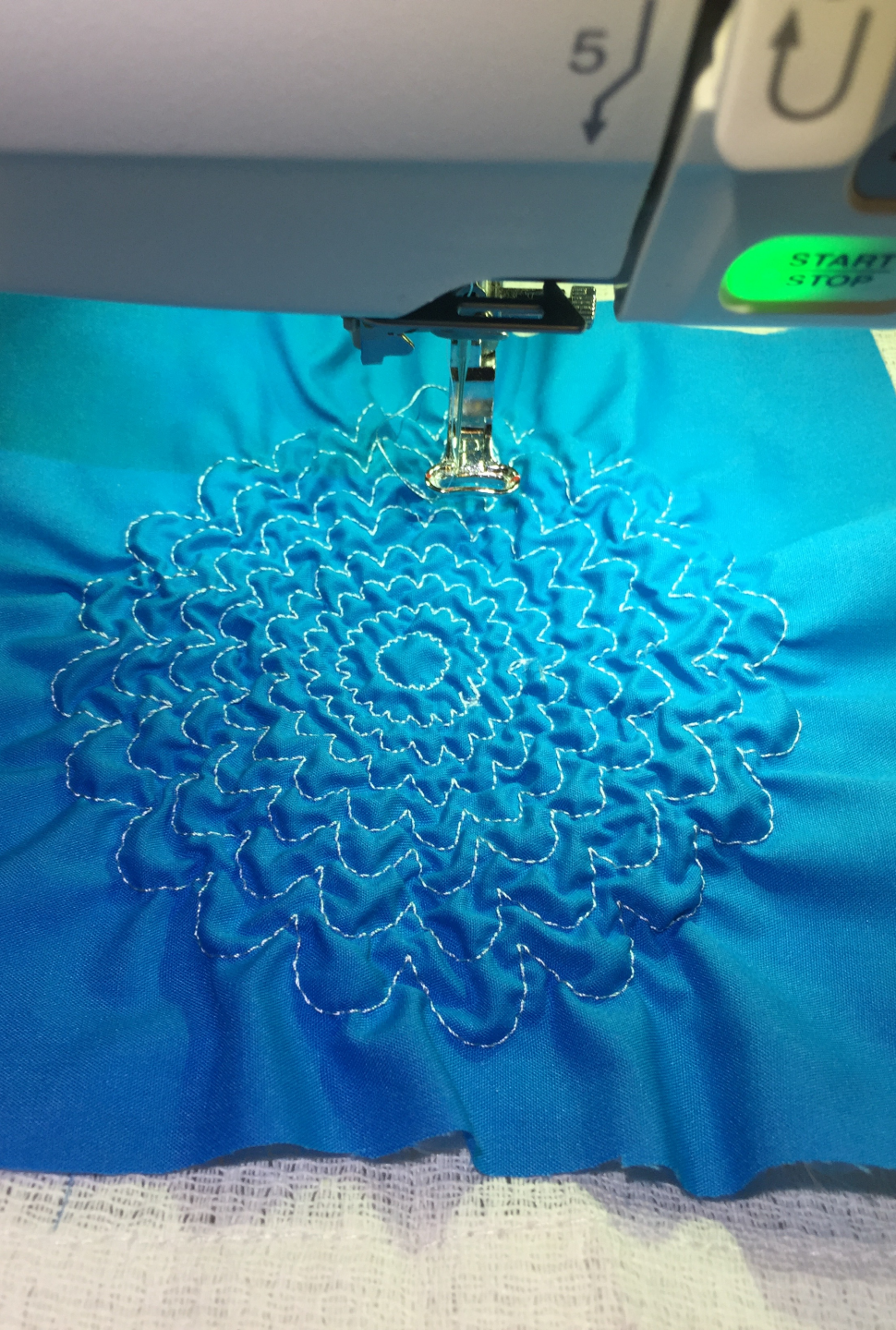


## Step 2:

- Remove fabric from hoop
- Turn iron to steam setting
- When iron is producing steam, hover it over fabric side of embroidered filet pattern until fabric shrinks. This may take a few seconds. You can't over do the steam—you will see when the fabric has shrunk as much as it can







## Step 3:

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- Hoop base fabric (I used a hand towel) and stabilizer
- Load Textured Flower Applique embroidery file
- Sew color 1, applique position. Place textured flower applique fabric (the fabric that is now shrunk) atop the applique position
- Sew color 2, outline for flower applique



## Step 3 cont'd

- Remove hoop from machine, but do not remove applique from hoop!
- Trim around flower applique outline





## Step 4:

- Replace hoop in machine
- Sew color 3, satin stitch flower outline







## Step 4 cont'd

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- Sew color 4, leaves
- Sew color 5, flower details
- Complete!
