

Reindeer Coasters

Supplies Needed:

- Janome Horizon Memory Craft 15000
- Circular Sewing Attachment
- Blue Tip Needle
- White Prewound Bobbin
- Thread to match fabric
- Pinking shears (optional)

Fabric and Notions:

- Approximately 1/2 yard of print cotton fabric
- 12" square of white felt
- Thread
- Scissors
- Plastic canvas 6" circle (optional)



Instructions:

- Set up the MC15000 for embroidery.
- Select the design from Every Day and Holiday #6 for the reindeer.



- Select the edit screen and reduce the design 80%. Select OK.
- Proceed to the ready to sew screen.
- Advance to the second section passing the first section of embroidery.
- Place the fabric and felt in the SQ14 hoop.

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- Stitch it out.
- Set up the machine for ordinary sewing.
- Select stitch #5 utility triple stitch.
- Attach the circular sewing attachment per the instructions. Set it at 2 3/4”.



- Locate the center of the design and place it on the pin.
- Take one 12” square and fold it in half and place on the pin. Place it about 1” past the pin.
- Take that other 12” square fold in half and place it on the pin. Place it overlapping the previous piece.
- Sew the two pieces in place.
- Remove from the sewing machine and trim. Note - trim with pinking shears for a smoother turn.
- Press, turn right side out and press again.
- Insert plastic canvas circle

*Special Note - the coaster can be made any size by using either Artistic Suite or DMBX software.
