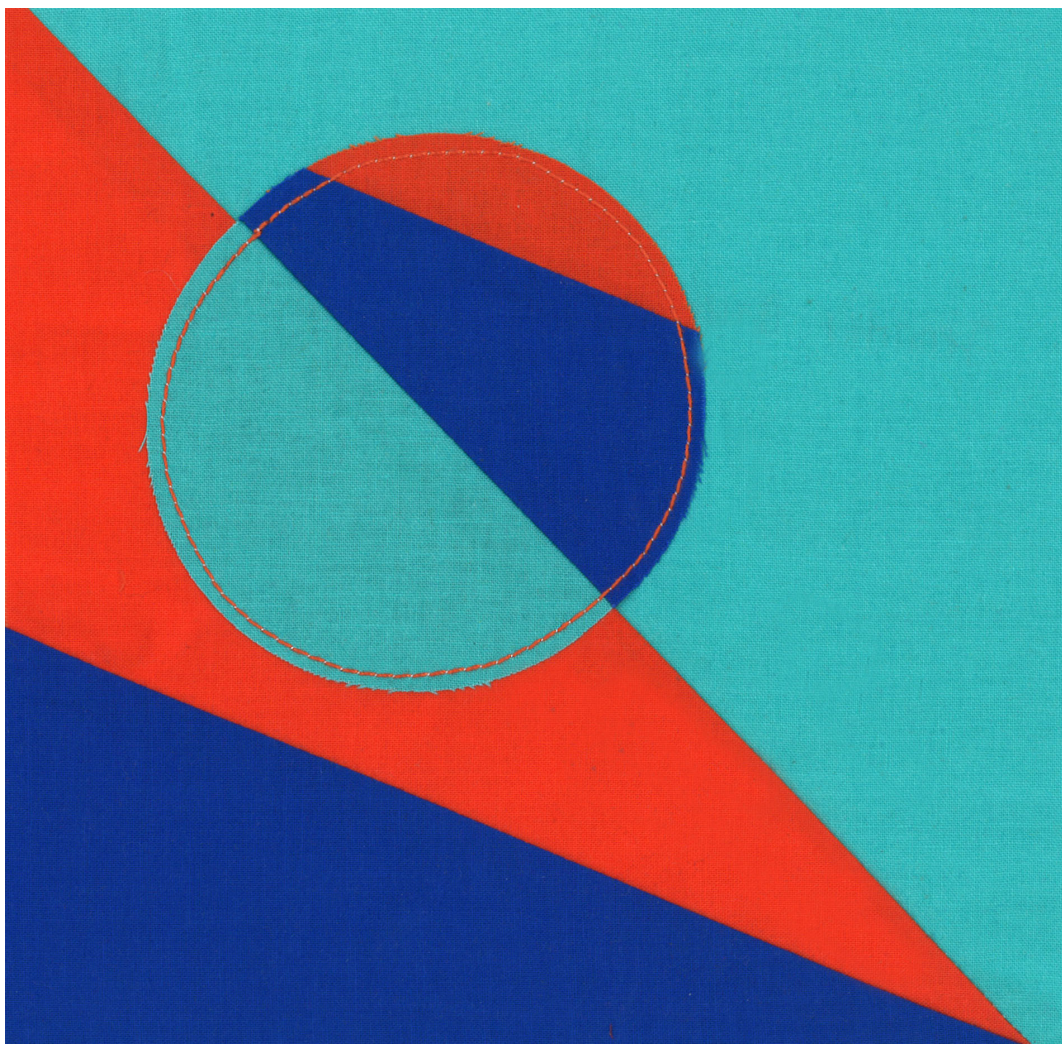


Jennifer Davey Abstract Circle Spot Block

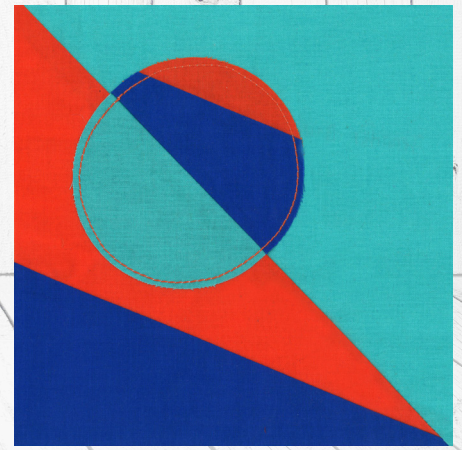

Planning:

- Use Lava, Luna and Cobalt fabrics to create 2 mirrored blocks.

Cutting Instructions:

- One 7" x 7" triangle of the Cobalt fabric. Cut in half from corner to corner.
- One 7" x 2 3/4" triangle of both the Lava and Luna fabrics. Cut in half from corner to corner.

Piecing the Block:

- Sew a Lava and Luna triangle together to make half of the block. Reference Diagram 1.
- Sew the triangles together to create a 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" block. Create two blocks in same manner and then press. Reference Diagram 2.
- Press Heat n' Bond Feather light to back of one block. Cut a 3" circle with the center line in the center. Reference Diagram 3.
- Press the circle in place on the completed square and stitch around edge with scant seam allowance. The block will be 6"x 6".

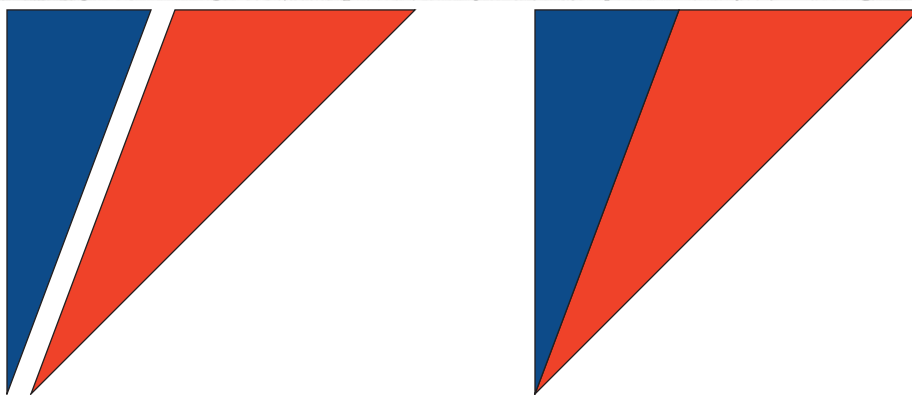
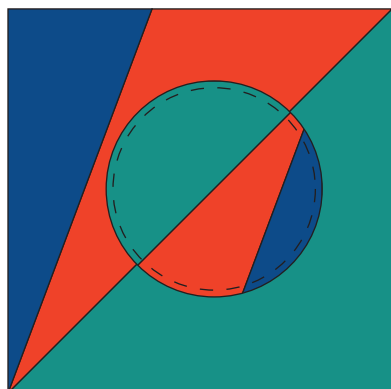
