
Trina Gallop Finding Arrowheads Block







Cutting Instructions:

From the Plum: One 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle From the Cobalt: One 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle From the Jewel: One 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle From the Lagoon: One 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle

From the Luna: One 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" strip
One 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strip

Two 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

Eight 1 1/2" squares

Instructions:

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each of the eight 11/2" Luna squares.
- 2. With right sides together, place a 11/2" Luna square on one side of a 11/2" x 21/2" Plum rectangle. Sew on the drawn line and trim to a 1/4" beyond the seam line. Press toward the Plum
- 3. Repeat step two with the Cobalt, Jewel and Lagoon rectangles to make a total of four flying geese units.
- 4. Following the image and noting orientation, stitch the four flying geese units together.
- 5. Stitch a 11/2" x 21/2" Luna rectangle to the Plum flying geese unit. Stitch a 11/2" x 21/2" Luna rectangle to the Lagoon flying geese unit.
- 6. Stitch the 1 1/2" Luna strip to the right of this. Stitch the 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" Luna strip to the right to complete the 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" block.
