


Cutting Instructions:

From the Plum: Four 2" squares (A) One 4 1/4" square; recut into four quarter square triangles (B) One 3 1/2" square (D)

From the Cobalt: Four 2 3/8" squares; recut into eight half square triangles (C)

From the Avocado: Four 1/2" squares

Sewing Instructions:

- Draw a diagonal line on the back of each 1/2" Avocado square. Place the square right sides together on the corner of a 2 3/8" Cobalt half square triangle and stitch on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance to a 1/4" and press open. See Diagram 1 and repeat for all four Cobalt half square triangles.
- Stitch an Avocado/Cobalt C half square triangle to one side of a Plum B quarter square triangle. Repeat to add a C triangle to the other side. Refer to Diagram 1 and repeat to make a total of four B/C pieces.
- Stitch a 2" Plum A square to either side of a B/C unit, noting orientation according to the Block Diagram to create the first row. Repeat to stitch a second row.
- Sew a B/C unit to either side of the Plum D 3 1/2" square, noting orientation according to the Block Diagram.
- Sew the three rows together to complete the 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" block.
