

Nydia Kehnle Retro Bloom Block

There are four templates to create the 6" finished quilt block.

Cut:


Cut four for each section to complete the entire block.

- 1: 1 1/2" x 2 1/4" (Lipstick)
- 2: 2" x 2" (Lava)
- 3: 2" x 2" (Lava)
- 4: 2 1/4" x 1 3/4" (Jewel)
- 5: 2 1/4" x 1 3/4" (Jewel)
- 6: 4" x 1 1/4" (Plum)
- 7: 2 1/2" x 1 1/4" (Gold)
- 8: 2" x 3 1/4" (Jewel)


Use a larger needle and a small stitch length for easy perforation.




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
Cover section 1 with fabric 1 lay section 2 on top overlapping the line inbetween 1 and 2 by at least 1/4"






Trim to 1/4"




Fold fabric for section 2 over and press

Step 5 Plain side of paper


place fabric for section 3 on top, overlapping the line between1 and 3 by at least 1/4"








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
Repeat steps until you have all pieces stitched Step 14
