
# LuAnn Hartley Variation on Ohio Star Block

## Cutting Directions:

- Cut two Gold 2 7/8" squares
- Cut two Lipstick 2 7/8" squares

Quarter Square Units:

- Cut two Sailor 3 1/4" squares
- Cut two Cobalt 3 1/4" squares

#### Center Square:

• Cut one Sailor 2 1/2" square

### Sewing Directions:

- Place one Gold 2 7/8" square on a matching Lipstick 2 7/8" square with the right sides together.
- Draw a line from corner to corner and sew a 1/4" from either side of the line. Use the drawn line to cut apart.
- Repeat with the set of 2 7/8" squares and press the seam toward the dark. Make four half square triangles.
- Place one Sailor 3 1/4" square on a Cobalt 3 1/4" square with the right sides together.
- Draw a line from corner to corner. Turn the block and do the same thing on the other side.
- Sew a 1/4" away from either side of one drawn line as before.
- Cut apart between the stitches.
- Use the other line as a cutting line and make four sets.
- Do the same for the other set of Sailor and Cobalt 3 1/4" squares.
- Put them together as shown below.



• Assemble the blocks in rows and then attach the rows following the picture and noting orientation.
