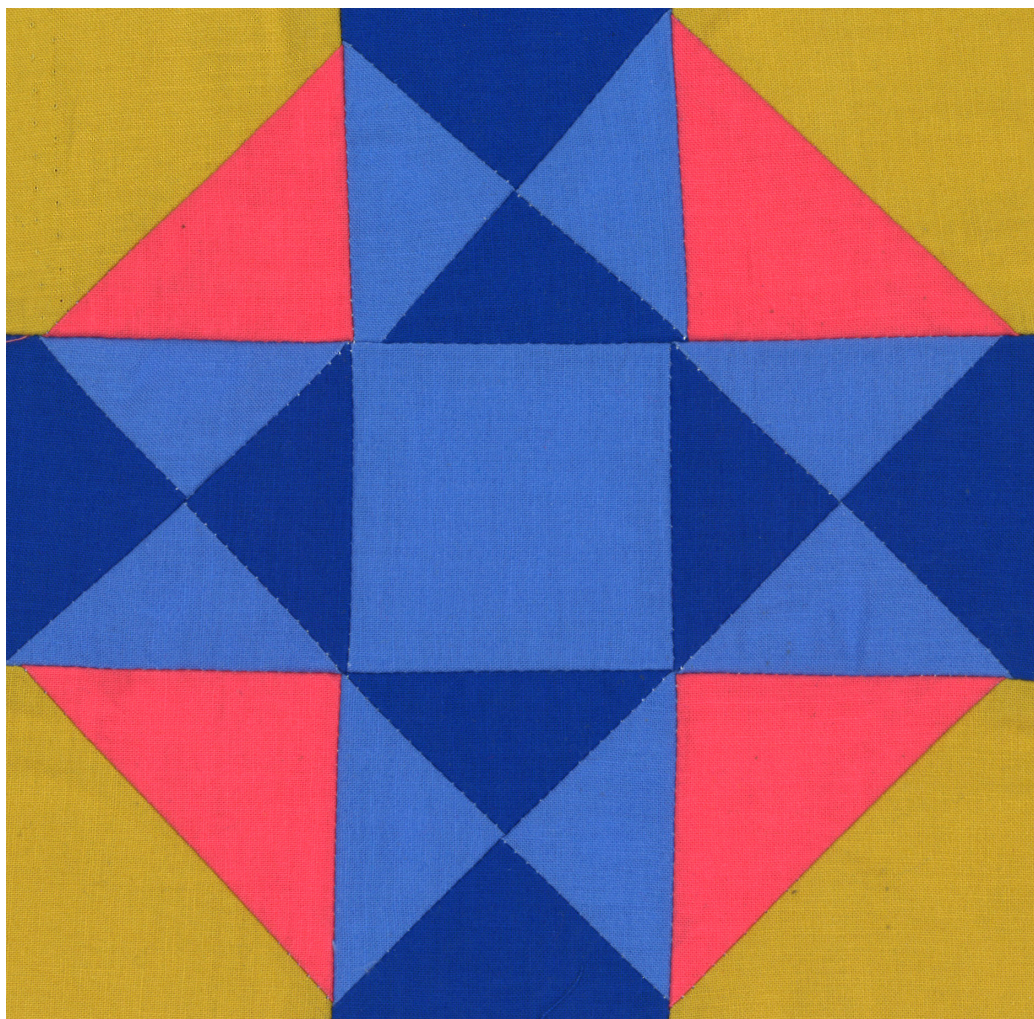


# LuAnn Hartley

## Variation on Ohio Star Block



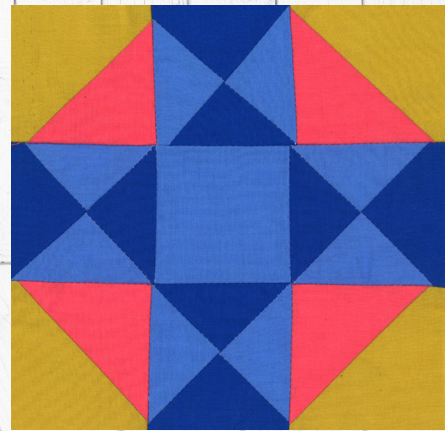
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WHAT'S NEXT

### Cutting Directions:

- Cut two Gold  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares
- Cut two Lipstick  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

### Quarter Square Units:

- Cut two Sailor  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares
- Cut two Cobalt  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares

### Center Square:

- Cut one Sailor  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square

### Sewing Directions:

- Place one Gold  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " square on a matching Lipstick  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " square with the right sides together.
- Draw a line from corner to corner and sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from either side of the line. Use the drawn line to cut apart.
- Repeat with the set of  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and press the seam toward the dark. Make four half square triangles.
- Place one Sailor  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " square on a Cobalt  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " square with the right sides together.
- Draw a line from corner to corner. Turn the block and do the same thing on the other side.
- Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from either side of one drawn line as before.
- Cut apart between the stitches.
- Use the other line as a cutting line and make four sets.
- Do the same for the other set of Sailor and Cobalt  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares.
- Put them together as shown below.



- Assemble the blocks in rows and then attach the rows following the picture and noting orientation.

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
