
## Angie Wilson Split 9 Patch Block





- — a story in every stitch



## Cutting Instructions:

From Lava: One 2 1/2" square Two 2 7/8" squares

From Cobalt: Two 2 1/2" squares

From Plum: One 2 1/2" square Two 2 7/8" squares

From Lagoon: Two 2 1/2" squares

General Instructions:

- Read pattern prior to commencing
- All seams are a 1/4"
- Press seams open
- Press between each step




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- 1. Take one 2 7/8" lava square and draw a line on the wrong side of the fabric from one corner to the other. Place the right sides together with a 2 7/8" plum square.
- 2. Stitch a line a 1/4" from the drawn line on either side (as per red lines on a diagram).
- 3. Cut along the drawn line to make two half square triangles.
- 4. Press
- 5. Repeat steps 1-4 to make another half square triangle.
- 6. Arrange the squares as per diagram.
- 7. Stitch the rows together and sew to complete the  $6 \frac{1}{2} \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$  block.




