Cutting Instructions:
From Lava: One $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square
Two 2 7/8" squares

From Cobalt: Two 2 1/2" squares

From Plum: One 2 1/2" square
Two 2 7/8" squares
From Lagoon: Two 2 1/2" squares

General Instructions:

- Read pattern prior to commencing
- All seams are a $1 / 4$ "
- Press seams open
- Press between each step


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1. Take one $27 / 8$ " lava square and draw a line on the wrong side of the fabric from one corner to the other. Place the right sides together with a $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ plum square
2. Stitch a line a $1 / 4$ " from the drawn line on either side (as per red lines on a diagram).
3. Cut along the drawn line to make two half square triangles.
4. Press
5. Repeat steps 1-4 to make another half square triangle.
6. Arrange the squares as per diagram.
7. Stitch the rows together and sew to complete the $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ block.


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The block should measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
