
Kaye Wood Hexagon Star





- a story in every stitch





Fabric and Notions:


- Cobalt Fabric
- Plum Fabric
- Jewel Fabric
- Quilter's ruler with 60 degree angle lines

Hexagon:

- Cut 5" x 6" pieces of fabric.
- Fold on a 6" width and press. (2 1/2" x 6")
- Place a 60 degree line on the fold; lining up the outside edge of the ruler with the right hand edge of the fabric.
- Cut
- Repeat on the opposite side.
- Unfold and press the hexagon.









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

Star Points:

- Cut six 3" squares and fold in half. Press.
- Fold and press the corners of each piece into the center.
- Sew on the star point to each side of the hexagon. Use a 1/4" seam allowance.

Background:

- Cut two 1 1/4" x 4" pieces.
- Sew to the top and bottom of the hexagon.
- Press the seam allowance away from the hexagon.
- Line up the ruler with the outside edge of the hexagon.
- Trim the ends of the pieces.
- Cut two 3" x 5 1/2" pieces.










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- With the right sides together, cut diagonally from the top to the bottom corner.
- Sew a triangle to each top corner of the block, matching the top of the hexagon.
 The triangles will extend past the side of the center point.
- Press toward the triangles.
- Sew a triangle to each bottom corner, matching the bottom of the hexagon.
- The narrow end of the triangles will overlap the top triangles.
- Press the seam allowance toward the triangles.
- Trim the block to 6 1/2".









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
