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Cutting Instructions:
Lipstick: Cut four 1" $\times 3$ " pieces (1)
Cobalt: Cut four $1^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (2)
Lava: Cut four $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (3)
Luna: Cut four $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (4)
Gold: Cut four $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (5)
Lagoon: Cut four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ pieces and a 2" square for the center (6)

Instructions:

- Sew a \#1 piece to two opposite sides of the square.
- Press the seam allowances away from the center square. Press from the right side of the fabric, no steam.
- Center the square on the cutting mat, line up the corner of the ruler at a 45 degree angle as shown so tht the outside edges of the ruler touch the seam line. (The tip of the ruler will extend past the fabric.)
- Cut a 1" strip on both sides of the ruler. Repeat on the opposite side.
- Sew the \#1 pieces (Lipstick) to the remaining sides of the center square and press the seams.



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- Center the square on the cutting mat. Place the ruler at a 45 degree angle as shown so that the outside edges of the ruler line up with the angled edges of the first sewn strips.
- Cut the strips on both sides of the ruler. Repeat on the opposite side.
- Sew the \#2 pieces (Cobalt) to the two opposite sides and press the seam.
- Place the ruler at a 45 degree angle as
shown so that the outside edges of the ruler line up with the angled cuts.
- Cut the strips on both sides of the ruler. Repeat on the opposite side.
- Sew the \#2 pieces to the remaining sides of the center square and press the seams. Trim the strips as before.
- Continue adding pieces, pressing and trimming to complete the block.
