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Cutting the Fabric:

*Extra supply needed

- Cut a 6 1/2" Avocado square.


Instructions:

- Trace the three templates below onto paper-backed fusible webbing. Roughly cut them out leaving a 1/2" around the design. Press the large fire onto the Gold fabric. Press the small fire onto the Lava fabric. Press the wood template onto the Plum fabric.
- Cut out the designs with paper and fabric together. Remove the paper and layout the design with the wood starting at a 1/4" up from the bottom and centered with 3/4" on each side. Be sure it is leveled because the two fire pieces will line up for the whole block. Press the Plum wood piece in place. Stitch in place. You may choose a straight forward edge applique or a blanket stitch.
- Layout the large Gold fire next, lining it up so the top point is centered and the bottom lines up with the wood and then press. Stitch in place as above.
- Layout the small Lava fire on top of that so the bottom lines up and it is centered and then press. Stitch in place as above.

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
