

FOOTBALL TABLE RUNNER

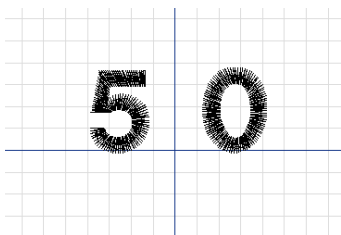


Supplies Needed:

- Janome Embroidery Sewing Machine
- Two—14" x 77" Green flannel pieces
- Thirteen—½" wide x 14" long white flannel pieces fused with fusible web
- Designs from Embroidery Library Inc. [Football Touchdown Flames F5483](#) and [Football A5282](#)

Instructions:

1. Locate center of green runner and fuse first white stripe.
2. Measure 5" over and fuse another one until you have a total of 5 stripes to one side.
3. Repeat the previous step to the opposite side of the runner until you have a total of 11 stripes.
4. From the last stripe on each side measure over 10" and fuse 1 stripe. You will have a total of 13 strips fused.
5. Numbers are stitched 1½" from the raw edge of the fabric.
6. Use the built in Med Size numbers from the font section of the machine. Leave ½" space between each number. Numbers are 2 grid lines apart.



7. You will need to bring the numbers in one at a time in order to move them where you want them in the edit screen.
8. Embroider Touchdown! Football and Flames in center.



9. Embroider the Football design on the 2 ends.



10. Place the right sides together and sew all the way around using a ½" seam allowance leaving an opening for turning.
11. Clip corners, turn to the right side and stitch opening closed.
12. Press Flat
