Cutting Chart and Overview:

All blocks measure 8-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished unless otherwise noted.

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Block J

Cut:

Background fabric:

- 4 - 2½" Side B triangles

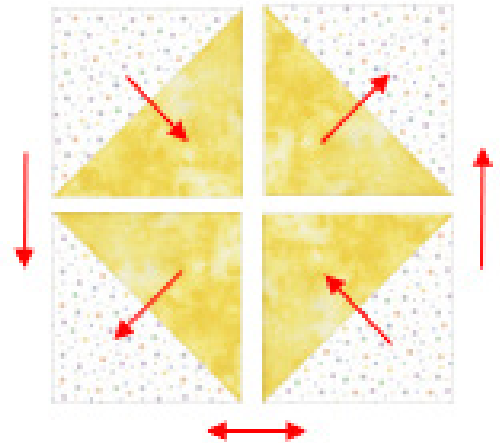
Lemon:

- 4 - 2½" Side B triangles you cut previously

NOTE: Block J measures 4½" x 4½" unfinished

Block Construction:

- Make 4 - 2½" HSTs using the Lemon and background fabrics.
- Press the seams in two of the HSTs towards the Lemon triangles and the other two HSTs towards the background fabric triangles.
- Square-up the block to 4½" x 4½".



Block K

Cut:

Background fabric:

- 2 - 2½" Side A triangles
- 4 - 2½" Side B triangles

Citrus, Lime, Seaweed, Lagoon, Mint, Turquoise, Royal, Sapphire, Pansy, Lavender, Lemonade, Pink, Cherry, Maraschino, and Flame:

- 2 - 2½" Side A triangles
- 4 - 2½" Side B triangles

Orange:

- Use 2 - 2½" side A triangles and 4 - 2½" side B triangles you cut previously

Block Construction:

- Make 17 Flying Geese units as shown and in the color order as listed above.
- Press the seams in each individual FG unit toward the Side B triangles.
- It is important to square up each individual FG unit to 2½" x 4½" before sewing them together in order.
- After sewing the FG units together in a long strip unit, press all the seams as shown by the red arrow.
- Block K unit should measure 4½" x 34½".
- Repeat the process to make 2 - Block K units (for a total of 34 Flying Geese units.)
